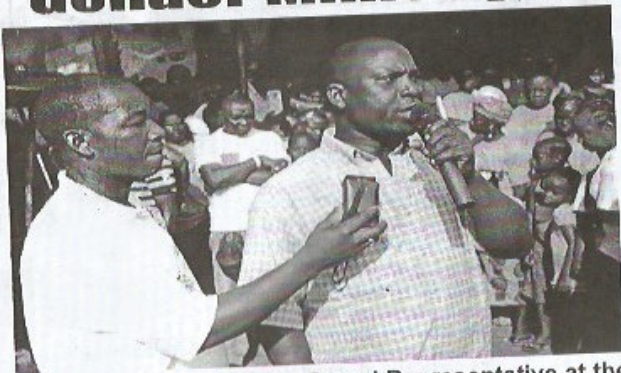

The campaign took place on October 27 and ended on the October 31, 2015.

The five-day sensitization campaign was held under the theme "End Violence Against Children" (EVAC) targeted thirteen communities in Brewerville city and Virginia Township with the full participation of local

leaders and men. According to the Gender based violence representative, Mr. Simon Coin, data collected highlights District 17 as a hotspot where children are been raped on a daily basis.

Mr. Simon Coin said, parents must always keep their children in a sight distance were they will be

secured at all times. He also said the campaign included the distribution of flyers, performances by local Liberian artists and prevention and responds messages

Also speaking was the campaign Manager of P.C.I Media Impact, Mr. Joko G.Kpogba. He added that responses emanating from

community members made him convinced that sexual violence against women and children in district 17 will be put under controlled.

Quoting statistics from the Ministry of Gender, he said 94 cases of violence against children especially rape occurred between 2014 and the second quarters of 2015 in those communities. He said 75 percent of the survivors were between ages of year to 17 years.

He went on to say women and girls remain more vulnerable to sexual and gender based violence in their communities.

Mr. Kpogba used the occasion to call parents, guidance and community leaders to not compromise issues of rape and other forms of violence.
