We expect interns to join us for at least three months and working an average of three to four days a week.

### Job Description

During the internship you will gain first-hand experience in what it takes to plan, implement and evaluate international health communication programs.

You will be involved in the following areas and tasks:

- Research up to date information and program interventions on topics of interest
- Write for website, social media and internal/external communication
- Provide editing to internal and external communication materials
- Support the program team on day-to-day program activities
- Support the design and development of Information, Education and Communication (IEC) products
- Support trainings and workshops for program partners, radio hosts, stakeholders and production teams in intervention countries
- Support monitoring and evaluation and report writing
- Support fundraising and administrative support

- Academic background in social sciences, communication, communication for development, or a related field
- Strong academic and creative writing skills
- Experience writing for both technical and layperson audiences
- Interest in health and/or development issues
- Program planning, management and evaluation skills
